

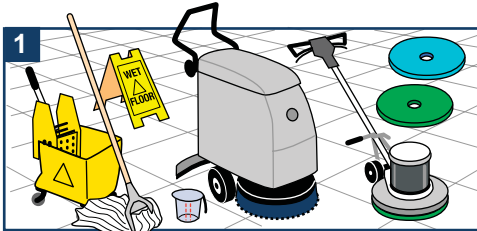
Top Scrubbing Floors



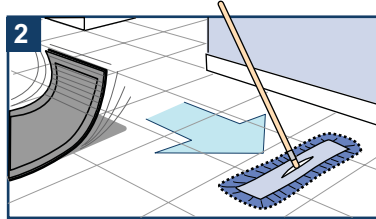

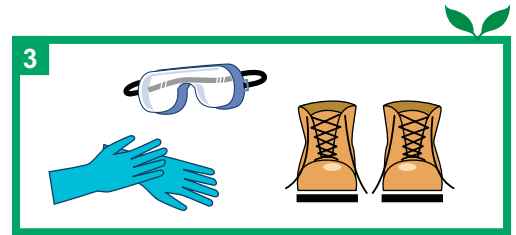

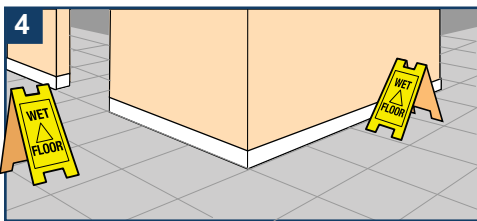
1 Gather equipment.



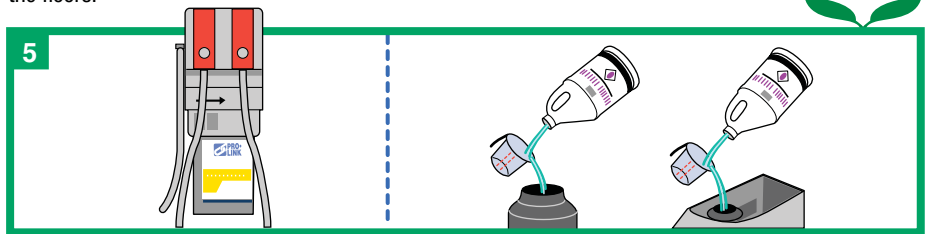
2 Remove entrance mats and dust mop the floors.



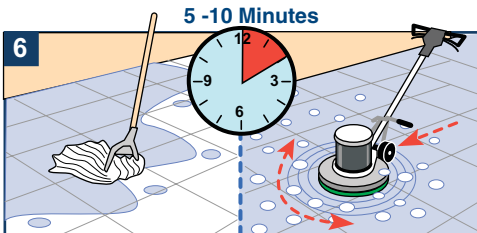
3 Wear proper personal protective equipment.



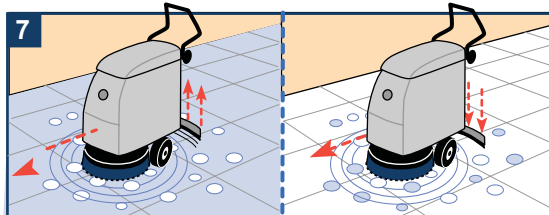
4 Place wet floor signs at all entranceways.



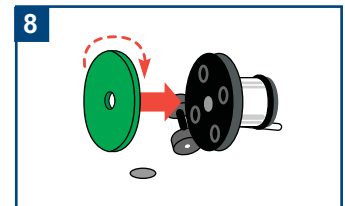
5 Mix the cleaning solution properly.



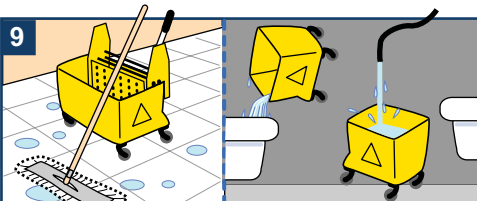
6 When rotary scrubbing, apply the cleaning solution liberally on the floor. Allow 5 - 10 minutes dwell time. Use a clean green or blue pad.



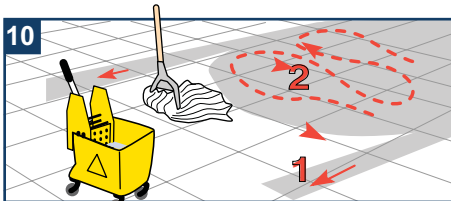
7 When using an autoscrubber, use the double scrub method with a green or blue pad: autoscrub without the vacuum on, then autoscrub with the vacuum on and the solution turned off.



8 Flip or change the pad as needed.



9 Damp mop rinse with clean water. Change the water frequently.



10 After the floor is dry, apply 2-3 coats of finish.

Green Cleaning Tips

- Top Scrubbing on a regular basis will reduce the number of times stripping will be required.
- Use the proper chemical mixture.
